Phase 1 – Documentation and Mobilities Activity A1 – Documentation

TRANSMOD researchers have undertaken national mobilities at the Romanian Academy Library in Bucharest for documentation and peer discussions in order to have access to materials (journals, handbooks) and gain knowledge in the field of transversal skills (definition, examples, good practices, implementation guidelines), and therefore improve their own understanding of the issue. The discussions were held between project members and professors from:

Phase 1 – Documentation and Mobilities Activity A2 – Virtual and Actual Mobilities

TRANSMOD team members carried on their documentation activities in the field of transversal skills, with a view to identifying good case practices for the integration of transversal skills in modern teaching practice.

A draft of the questionnaire was also drawn up, in order to be discussed during transnational mobilities undertaken in the last week of August by two members of the Romanian team, who visited both partner universities (Bifröst University and Nesna University College).

Faza 2 – Detection and Assessment of Actual Needs Activity A3 – Questionnaire-Based Preliminary Research

An analysis of the comments made by project members on the pilot-questionnaire was made. The final and complete version of the questionnaire (available in English and Romanian) was created and published using Google Forms, then sent to the three partner universities and provided to teaching staff.
