### Phase 4 - Results Validation and Final Design of the Guide Activity A6 - Joint (International) Seminar

The Joint International Seminar took place on April 28 and 29 at the University of Craiova and its primary aim was to reunite all the members of the project, summarize the intermediary results and obtain the final versions of the materials for the Good Practice Guide. April 28 witnessed the presentation of 16 scientific contributions to be integrated in the Good Practice Guide.

The activities performed on April 29 included two working sessions and a conclusions session. During the conclusions session, the members agreed on the structure of the Good Practice Guide and talked about possibilities to pursue the project (thus ensuring its sustainability).

All the submissions were rigorously reviewed, proofread and edited by a team of specialists. Translation was provided for all submissions, so as to have a volume in English and one in Romanian language. The contributions to the guide deal with a wide array of topics, with transversal skills acting as the leading thread. Besides the project-centred presentations, the guide includes contributions that may be suggestively summed up as Good Practice... in Practice.

### Phase 4 - Results Validation and Final Design of the Guide Activity A9 - Dissemination

The dissemination activities of the entire project have focused on the presentation of the project results. Team members worked together in order to conceive promotional materials that would inform stakeholders on the main outcomes of the project. Furthermore, in order to reach an even larger number of people, seven team members undertook dissemination mobilities in five Romanian universities to promote the project and the Good Practice Guide: the "Lucian Blaga" University of Sibiu, the University of Piteşti, the West University of Timişoara, the Technical University of Cluj-Napoca and the University Centre of Drobeta Turnu-Severin. The project results and outcomes were also presented internally, within the Department of Economics, Accounting and International Business of the Faculty of Economics and Business Administration of the University of Craiova.
